The public body shall provide the officer, appointee or employee with such notice of the executive session as is appropriate but not less than twenty-four hours for the officer, appointee or employee to determine whether such discussion or consideration should occur at a public meeting.

Mayor Justice announced that Andrew Grim withdrew his application for the Magistrate position.

Motion made by Vice Mayor Cook to enter into executive session. The motion was duly seconded and passed upon a vote.


Mayor Justice reconvened the Special City Council Meeting at 4:14 p.m.
